

Curriculum with Teacher Contact (CTC) Courses

Snohomish Parent Partnership is offering a selection of courses in English, History, Health, Cooking and Physical Education in a format that can be used at home. We supply the curriculum and weekly assignment sheet; parents give the daily feedback/encouragement as the assignments are being completed.

Then the student meets with the instructor once a week in person, through e-mail, and/or by phone to turn in and discuss completed work and pick up the next week's work. The instructor and student will determine when and how this takes place. Once a student/teacher contact schedule is arranged, it is the student's responsibility to adhere to the schedule in order to successfully complete the CTC course. If the student elects to meet with their instructor in person, available times include: Tuesdays, before and after school; Wednesdays, 9 to 11 a.m.; and, Thursdays, before and after school.

Credit and a letter grade of "S" may be awarded for successful completion of a CTC courses.

We feel these courses will give you more flexibility with your schedule and may allow you to earn some required credits for graduation, even though the day and hour of our "in class" offerings may be limited.
