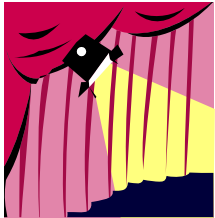
Mission Statement

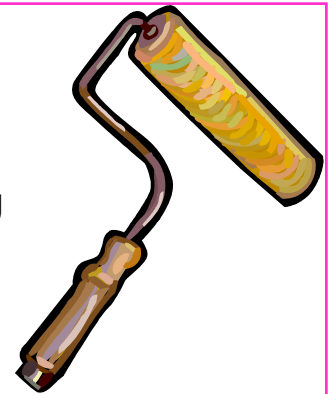
Come One, Come All!!
