## Where should I look for a scholarship?

- Local Scholarship Program create a profile on the WashBoard. Scholarships will be available starting December and due in February.

- TheWashboard.org. A scholarship matching search engine for Washington residents.

- The institution you will be applying to or attending. All schools have a financial aid/scholarship tab on their website. There are scholarships for applying, visiting, GPA, etc.
- Your employer/parents' employer (including any clubs or organizations you or they belong to).
- National Search Engine such as bigfuture.com, fastweb.com, scholarship.com
- GPHS College and Career Center website for specific scholarships



### File FAFSA!

Many institutions will not award merit scholarships without a FAFSA on file.



Scholarship search engines require you to check back frequently for new scholarships. If you are not returning a lot of scholarships, reevaluate the search criteria you entered.
