

eREADER PERMISSION SLIP

Dear Parents:

With the growing popularity with electronic readers (e-readers), many students have asked if they could use their devices (Kindle, Nook, etc.) at school. Part of our mission statement as a school is to develop strong academics and we encourage reading at any opportunity. However, students bringing a valuable piece of equipment to school can be a liability for you and we want to be clear with the expectations/guidelines that go along with bringing these devices to school.

We have developed the following guidelines:

- When brought to school, the e-reader **must** go home at the end of each day.
- Students may not access the Internet using their electronic reader. All downloading of books will be done at home prior to bringing the device to school.
- Students may not share their device with other students.
- Like all books, students will use the e-reader by reading school-appropriate material only.
- Students will use the e-reader while being supervised by the classroom teacher or corresponding specialists. They may not take the reader out to recess.

Please understand that the school district **cannot** be held liable if any damage to the e-reader occurs either on the way, at school, or on the way home. If the student does not follow these guidelines, they will not be able to bring their reader to school again.
