How does it work?

For example, taking Advanced CADD (yearlong) earns one credit toward the 24 required for graduation and fulfills two graduation requirements.

ONE CREDIT:

Advanced CADD

TWO REQUIREMENTS:

✓ 1 Requirement- CTE

✓ 1 Requirement- Art

- **Creates flexibility to choose more elective courses**
- **Can address other graduation requirements**

Students- check with your high school counselor or college admission offices to make sure the course will be accepted for admission purposes.
NCAA Requirements: Potential D1 or D2 athletes should check with their counselors annually regarding which Snohomish School District equivalency credits have been approved by the NCAA.

The current rule change to WAC 180-51-067 allows school districts to grant equivalency credit for courses offered in high schools.

Students who take a CTE-equivalency course may satisfy two graduation requirements while earning 1.0 credit for a yearlong course or 0.5 credit for a semester course; hence the "two for one".

CTE equivalencies are noted in the CTE program sections in this handbook.

WORLD LANGUAGE

Incoming Juniors should consider taking a World Language for the following reasons:

- To meet the World Language requirements for most colleges.
- Satisfy the two-year World Language graduation requirement by the end of Senior year.
- To begin the practice of becoming fluent in a World Language.

If Juniors are planning on applying to Sno-Isle Tech junior and/or senior year or have an alternate path other than four-year college, they should see their counselor about a PPR*.

- *Personal Pathway Requirements: Up to 3.0 credits chosen by a student, that are included in a student's High School and Beyond Plan and that prepare the student to meet specific post-secondary career or educational goals.
