

GLACIER PEAK HIGH SCHOOL - Student Short Term Parking Contract – Spring 2021

It is the goal of the Snohomish School District and GPHS to provide as many parking places as possible on our campus. **All students with a current driver's license will be issued a GP Parking Pass free of charge for the remainder of the school year, provided this contract has been completed, signed, and turned in.** Student parking is a privilege. Any student parking in a GP lot during school hours needs to have both parent and student, read, agree to and sign the following contract:

- Due to COVID safety protocols, **we ask you remain in your vehicle until 7:10am**, unless prior arrangements have been made with a teacher/staff member. Please wear your face mask as you exit your vehicle and practice social distancing.
- Once parked: **Please do not exit your vehicle and enter another vehicle or have others enter yours**. Please do not loiter before or after school hours.
- Parking Permit must be displayed on the driver's side of your dash where visible. If your permit is not in your vehicle, it is **your** responsibility to communicate this with the GPHS campus Security Monitor before 1st period begins. If you have lost or misplaced your permit, please request a replacement from GPHS Campus Security Monitor.
- Your Parking Permit is not transferable to other students. All students parking on campus must have their own contract completed.
- Drivers must obey Washington state laws including vehicle insurance requirements.

Violations include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Disregarding any of the above-mentioned expectations.
- Students are not permitted to go to (be at or in) a vehicle from the start of 1st period through the end of 6th period (including lunch) without written permission from the Security Monitor, Attendance Office Personnel or an Administrator.
- Driving & parking carelessly (examples: excessive speed, recklessness, squealing tires, texting).
- School inappropriate items on or in vehicle.
- Leaving campus without signing out (permission is required) at the GP attendance office.

Violation Consequences:

- Loss of parking privileges.
- You may be issued a fine. Multiple fines may result in loss of campus parking privileges during current or future year (Disputes on fines need to occur within 30 days).

Loss of campus parking privileges may result from school disciplinary action.

I am parking my vehicle at my own risk and accept responsibility for loss or damages I may incur. I agree that GPHS is not responsible for theft or vandalism of my vehicle or its contents. I understand that by parking on campus, my vehicle is subject to search. This parking pass may be revoked if the car contains any drugs (or drug delivery devices), alcohol, nicotine, vape, vape accessories or vape related contents; a knife, weapons, or any other violations of school policies. My parents and I have read and agree to the above expectations, rules and regulations.
