Facilities Planning

In order to efficiently manage the district's present and future facility's needs, a Capital Facilities Plan will be developed. This plan will cover a six-year period, will be developed in conjunction with the local comprehensive land-use plan and other growth management policies, will comply with the 1990 Growth Management Act, Chapter 36.70A RCW, as amended and including any future amendments thereto, and will be reviewed and updated bi-annually and include at least the following:

- 1. A cost analysis of financial ability of the district to implement its facilities program;
- 2. Existing and projected enrollment figures;
- 3. An inventory of the district's undeveloped property and developed facilities, including an analysis of the number of students in each facility and whether the facility is over or under-crowded;
- 4. An analysis of the appropriateness of the facilities to meet the needs of all students and members of the public, all district services, programs, and activities, ensuring that the facilities will be accessible to individuals with disabilities and appropriate for students regardless of gender;
- 5. Recommendations as to the sale or other disposition of district property not needed in the future; and
- 6. Recommendations as to the acquisition, construction, or modification of new sites or facilities and of how such will better meet the needs of students and the educational program.
