**WHEREAS**, many men and women in uniform have given their lives while serving in the Armed Forces; and

**WHEREAS**, citizens of our country and community have received the Purple Heart Medal as a result of being wounded while engaging in combat with an enemy force, construed as a singularly meritorious act of essential service; and

**WHEREAS**, Snohomish School District seeks to remember and recognize veterans who are recipients of the Purple Heart Medal; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Snohomish School District in Snohomish, Washington to be proclaimed a Purple Heart District, honoring the service and sacrifice of our nation's men and women in uniform, wounded or killed by the enemy while serving to protect our freedom and in recognition of our communities Purple Heart Medal recipients.
