### Disciplinary Removal of Students with Disabilities

Washington Administrative Code (WAC Chapter 392-400) defines suspension and expulsion procedures that school administrators may use to discipline students who have violated school rules. Students with disabilities are subject to the same rules governing student conduct as their non-disabled peers, subject to the limitations stated in WAC Chapter 392-172A and other applicable law.

The procedures in 3323P shall be followed for disciplinary removals of students with disabilities who qualify for special education services and/or Section 504 protection.
