

K-3 Highly Capable

IDENTIFICATION PROCESS

The K-3 highly capable program provides advanced learning opportunities with depth, complexity and acceleration for students in their current classroom and school.



REFERRAL

Discuss with your teacher if your child needs highly capable services or advanced learning opportunities.

Student may be referred by parent, teacher or community member to start referral process.

Pick up referral packet at your student's school. Fill out forms and return by date indicated on the packet.



TESTING

Student takes the Cognitive Abilities (CogAT) test.



REVIEW

Multi-disciplinary committee reviews referral information and assessment data to make recommendations.

Parents receive test results and decision from selection committee by mail.



PARTICIPATION

Students receive information about highly capable placement decisions.

Participation takes place in the student's home school and classroom.
