Community – Snohomish High School is a 9-12 comprehensive high school in the Snohomish School District. SHS is the home of the Panthers, where we have pride in what we do, and excellence in how we do it. We enjoy a long and rich tradition of serving the town of Snohomish and surrounding communities since graduating our first class in 1894.

Student Body - Enrollment for 2016-2017 is 1715 students, 51% male and 49% female.

Faculty - We have 95 certificated full-time and part-time teachers.

Accreditation – We are accredited through the Association of Educational Service Districts (AESD).

High School Graduation Requirements -

Attendance - Students graduating from SHS must attend eight semesters of high school or its equivalent and earn 22 credits. One-half credit is equal to one period of instruction for one semester of 90 days.

Credit Requirements - The subjects listed below are required for graduation and must be included in the 22 credits.

Community Service – Documentation of eight hours is required.

High School Proficiency Examination – Students must complete and pass the State of Washington high school proficiency examinations.
