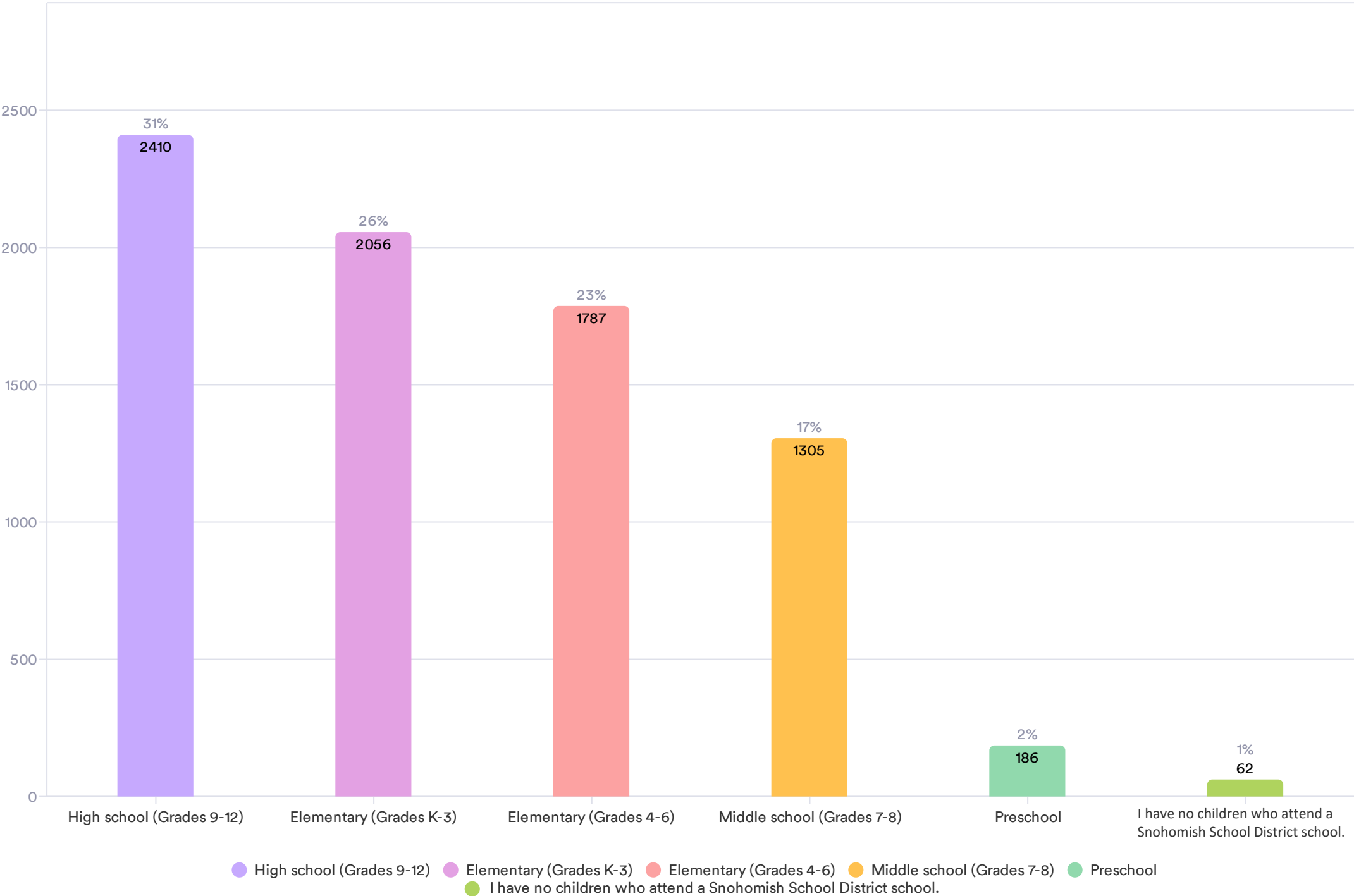


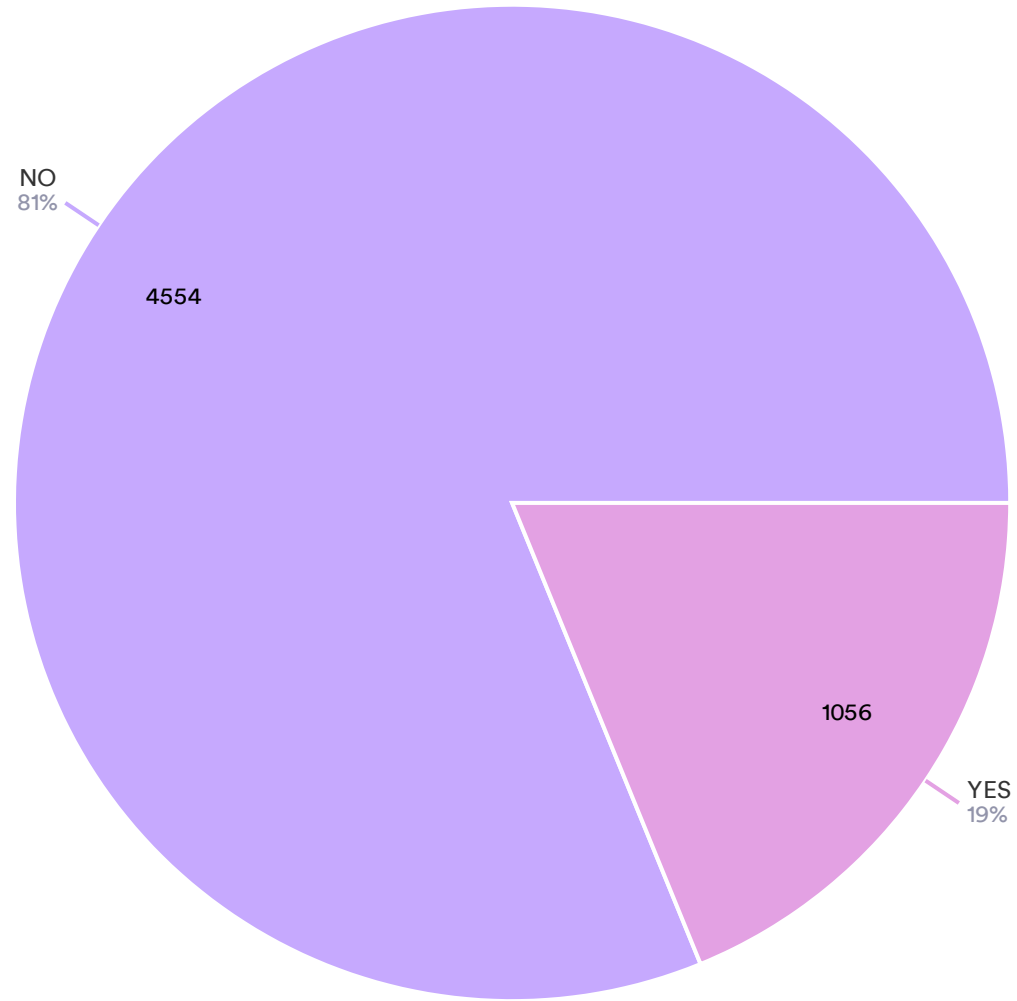
# What grade(s) is your child in? (Check all that apply)

# Does your child utilize school or district special services?

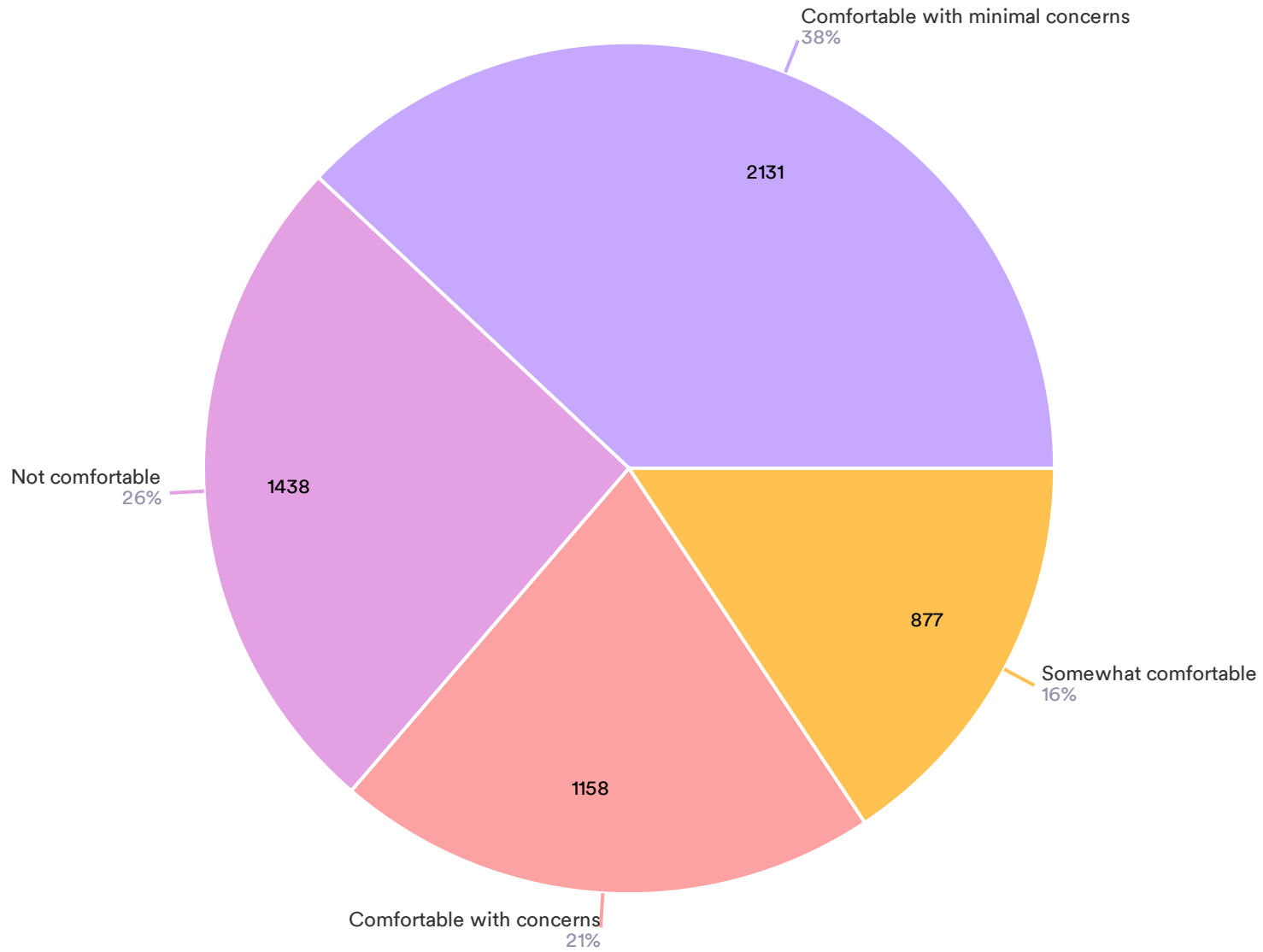

# How comfortable are you having your child return to school this fall knowing the school and district will take all required safety health precautions?

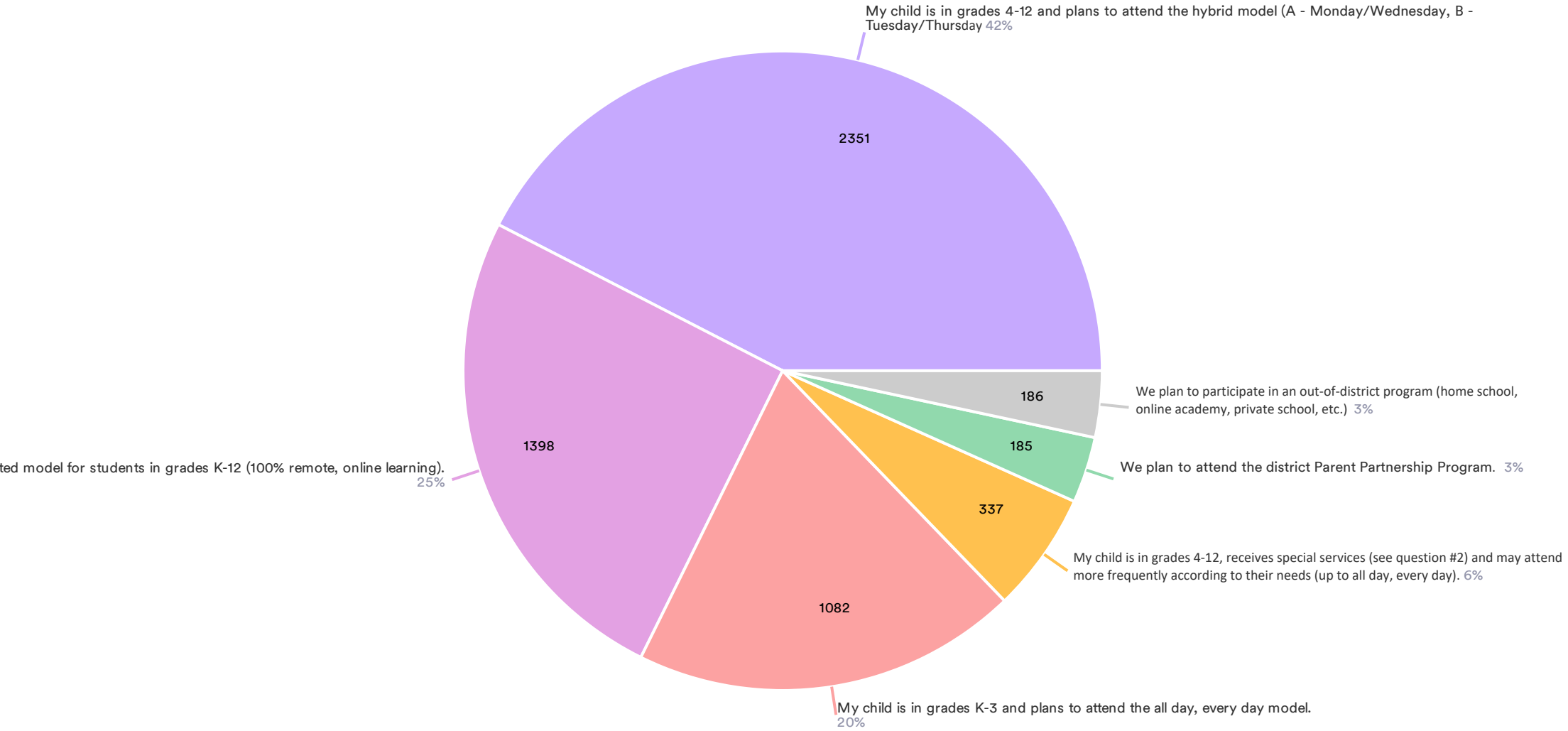

# Which educational delivery option do you most support for your child?

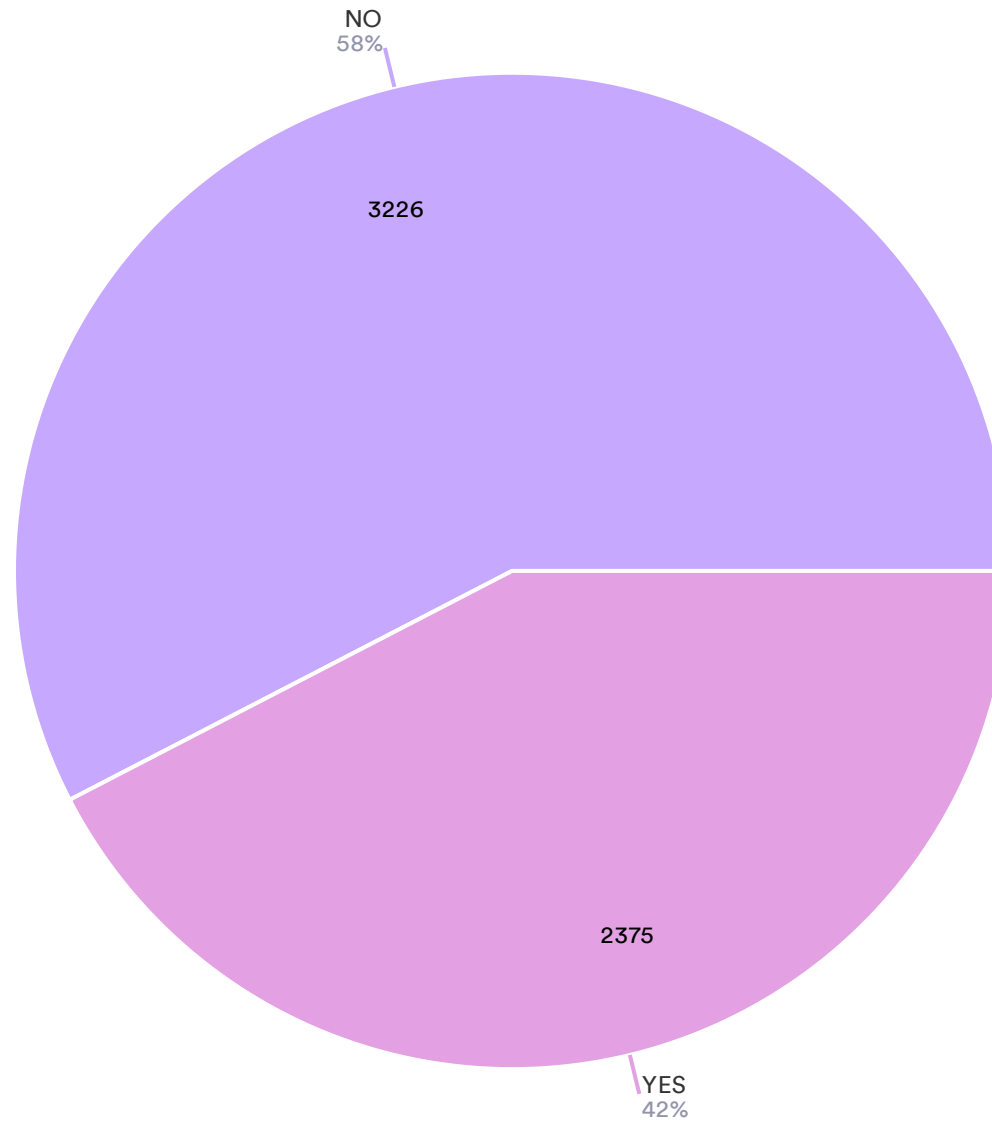

# Does your family plan to utilize district transportation (school busing) to get your child to/from school?

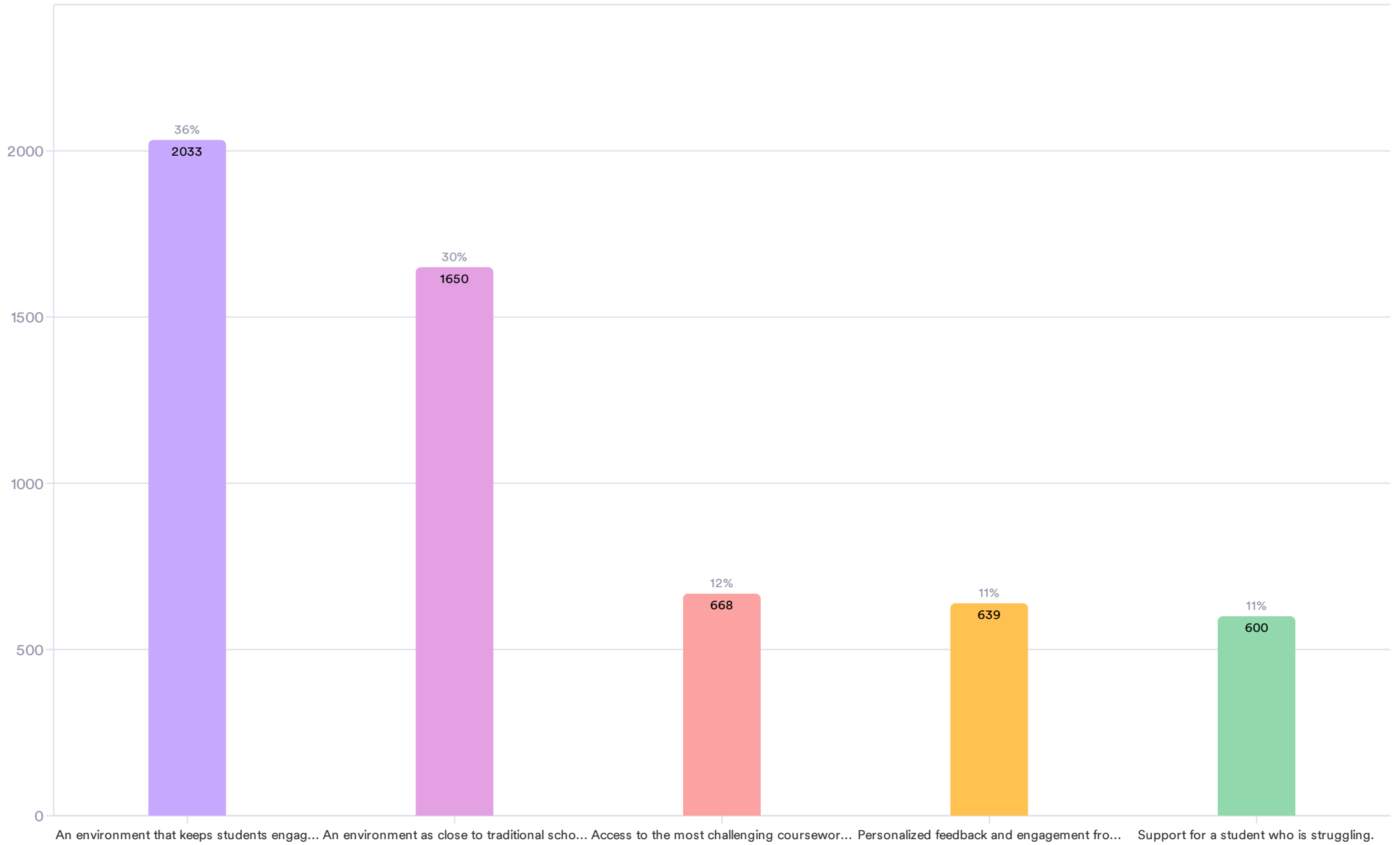
