We acknowledge the original inhabitants of this place, the Snohomish people, and their successors the Tulalip tribes, who since time immemorial have taken care of, hunted, fished, and gathered on these lands. We respect their sovereignty and their right to self-determination; and we honor their sacred spiritual connection with the land and water.

The **Snohomish** are a Lushootseed Native American tribe who reside around the Salish Sea (Puget Sound) area of Washington state, north of Seattle. They speak the Lushootseed language. The tribal spelling of their name is Sdoh-doh-hohbsh, which means "lowland people."
