



American Red Cross Adult and Pediatric First Aid Certification Course

The Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED blended learning course equips students to recognize and care for a variety of first aid breathing and cardiac emergencies involving adults, children, and infants.

This class is taught in a blended learning format. The online portion (accessed via mobile desktop or tablet) must be completed prior to attending the instructor-led skills session.

Upon successful completion, a valid 2-year digital certificate for Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED is issued.

- In-person skills session will take place on Monday, February 19 at the Snohomish Aquatic Center from noon-4 p.m.
- Participants must be 14 years or older to register.
- The cost of the blended training course is \$100 per participant. This includes the certification fee charged by the American Red Cross.
- Participants must be present for the entire in-person training and complete the online portion to receive a certificate.
- Students must provide an email address at the time of registration to receive the link and instructions for the online learning portion of the training.
