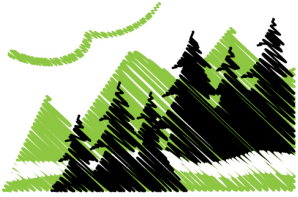
Sexual Health Curriculum Adoption Committee Application

The District's purpose for teaching sexual health is to provide our students with medically accurate and developmentally appropriate information to help them make decisions that impact their lifelong health and wellness. These lessons are also designed to help our students feel safe, informed, and empowered. To achieve this purpose, below are two committees charged with ensuring that curricular resources that we adopt to teach the lessons are aligned with state standards, state requirements, and district policy and procedure:

- a) **Resource Adoption Committee:** This committee recommends resources for adoption and consists of teachers, administrators, and Teaching and Learning Services staff.
- b) **Sexual Health Curriculum Adoption Committee:** This committee reviews staff, parent, student, and community input on the recommended resources and verifies that the district's process for adopting curricular resources was followed.

According to district policy and procedure 2125P, this committee will consist of the District's Instructional Materials Committee (IMC): six (6) teachers, four (4) parents (persons who have child(ren) attending Snohomish schools), two (2) building administrators, the Administrative Assistant for Teaching and Learning Services, the Executive Director of Teaching and Learning Services, and two (2) community at-large representatives (persons who may or may not have child(ren) in Snohomish schools). In addition to the Instructional Materials Committee, **two** community members who may or may not have child(ren) in Snohomish schools will also serve on the Sexual Health Curriculum Adoption Committee.
