This summer, I'd like you to choose one of the three novels listed below and write a beautiful literary analysis essay.

Choice #1: *The Hobbit*, by J.R.R. Tolkien

Choice #2: *A Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur's Court*, by Mark Twain

Choice #3: *Jane Eyre*, by Charlotte Bronte

After completing the book, write an essay in which you answer this prompt:

Is the protagonist of your book a hero? Why or why not?
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### Essay Requirements

- Strong thesis statement
- Well crafted sentences and paragraphs that support your thesis
- Three or more direct quotes from your book that support your assertions
- Please type and double space your final copy.
- Your essay should have a minimum of five excellent paragraphs.

Please bring your essay to class on the first full day of school. (You do not have to bring it on Freshman Orientation day.) I look forward to reading your work, and hearing your responses to these three novels.
