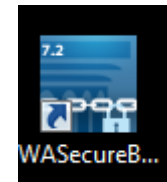


Smarter Balanced Training Test

To Access the Training test:

1. Have the student click on the secure browser shortcut on the desktop:
2. Have them click where it says “Click here to access training or practice tests.”
3. Outside of school, teachers and the greater community can access the practice test by going to wa.portal.airast.org and then click on Practice and training tests (Chrome browser works best):
