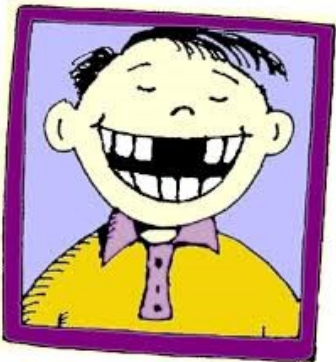
Doors open at 6:00p.m. and Book Fair runs 5:30p.m. to 8:30p.m.
