## Notes from the Nurse

**Vision screening** for children in grades K -3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> has been completed. Vision referrals were sent home during conferences if any concerns were detected. Students were screened using the SPOT photo vision screener, which detects potential indicators for a variety of visual issues including myopia (nearsightedness) and hyperopia (farsightedness). This screening is **not** intended to replace a regular vision exam from a licensed optometrist, however.

In addition, your child should receive a comprehensive optometric examination if he/she is experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- Consistently sitting too close to the TV or holding a book too close
- Losing his place while reading or using a finger to guide his eyes when reading
- Squinting or tilting the head to see better
- Frequent eye rubbing
- Sensitivity to light and/or excessive tearing
- Closing one eye to read, watch TV or see better
- Avoiding activities which require near vision, such as reading or homework, or distance vision, such as participating in sports or other recreational activities
- Complaining of headaches or tired eyes
- Avoiding using a computer because it "hurts his eyes"
- Receiving lower grades than usual

**Cold & Flu Season** is quickly approaching. Please remind your child(ren) to dress appropriately for the quickly changing weather. Hand washing is the first defense against the spread of germs and to cover a cough or sneeze with an inner elbow. Many area pharmacies and health care providers have flu vaccinations available.

**If medication is needed at school**, please have your health provider complete a medication authorization form for any prescribed medications, such as an inhaler. Students with a history of asthma flares during the cold/flu season may need to contact their health provider for preventative strategies.
