Mark your calendars for our Spring Into Kindergarten event. **All 2019-2020 kindergarten families and students should attend.**

Spring Into Kindergarten details:

- Wednesday, March 6, 2019
- 4:00p.m.–7:00p.m. (come at any time during the time period)
- **Families should return their kindergarten registration paperwork that day.** You can download and print the entire registration packet from the district website at:

We will also be conducting school tours and having important information available for families (WaKIDS, PTA/PTO/parent organizations, bus transportation, special services and more). For more information, please contact the front office at 360-563-4675

Items you should bring with you in order to complete the registration packet include:

- Child's birth certificate
- Child's immunization records
- Emergency contact information and phone numbers (at least 2)
- Name and phone number of your family doctor
- Parent's phone number at work
- Proof of address (see below)*
- Any relevant legal documents (parenting plans, protection orders, etc.)
- When registering students who have transferred from another school, please bring the name, address and phone number of the school.

*Our registration policy requires for any student/ parent to show proof of residency before acceptance into our school district. Proof of residency is:

- A current Snohomish County property tax statement (original) with the parent/guardian name and address. The address must be within the service area of your home school.
- A current utility bill (PUD, water, phone landline, etc.)
- Closing documents in home purchase – Documentation from a title company is acceptable. Purchase offers are not.
- **Note: Cell phone bills, vehicle registration and driver's licenses are not acceptable forms of proof.**

OVERDRIVE!!!

The Snohomish School District has OverDrive services for all students. Students can check out audio books and eBooks on their devices at home. OverDrive has created a new, more user-friendly app for students - Sora. If you have a Kindle at home you will need to access OverDrive through the original OverDrive app as they haven't created a Kindle app yet. Sora by OverDrive

- download Sora app from app store
- open app > "click find my school"
- choose Snohomish School District by clicking "this is my school"
- click "sign in using Snohomish School District 201"
- log in with student email address & password
 - ⇒ student's email address = first.last@studentssd.org
 - ⇒ password = the password the student uses at school to log-on to a school district computer)
- once open, students will be able to browse/hold/check out ebooks & audio books
