SBA testing for grades 3 – 6 will begin Monday, May 13th and run through Friday, May 24th with make-up testing the following week.

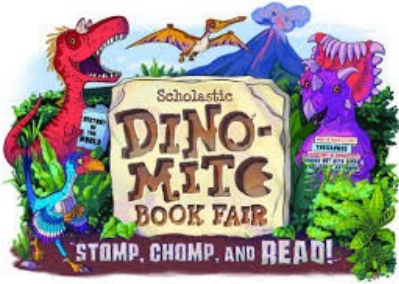
We will continue to keep you informed of upcoming events throughout the spring. I hope you have a marvelous Spring Break and find time to relax and be together as a family.
