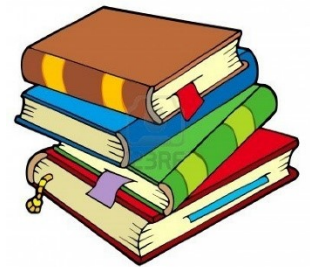
Donuts and juice will be served to all the Dads and their children 25 minutes prior to school. In order for this event to be successful, please be sure to RSVP if you are planning to attend.
