Dear Emerson Families,

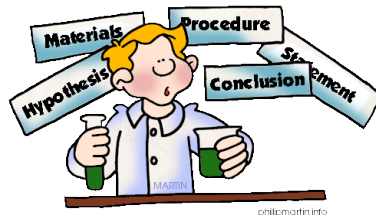
