Sexting

Under Washington State Law it is illegal to either possess or view sexually explicit images of minors.

Conviction of child pornography in the state of Washington carries some of the harshest penalties in the country, including jail time, fines, a criminal record, and registering as a sex offender for life.

WHAT IS CONSENT?

Consent: Giving permission for something to happen.

Sexual Consent: Agreeing to have sexual relations with someone



In the state of Washington a person must be 16 years old to consent to any sexual activity.

If under the age of 18 (16 or 17 years old) the person's partner must be no more than 5 years (60 months) older than them.

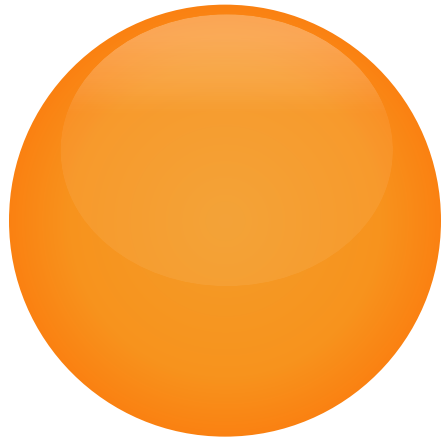


Rape is forcible sexual intercourse without the other person's consent. Force can be physical or emotional.

Sexual intercourse is penetration of either the vagina or anus and also includes oral sex.

Rape is a felony, conviction will result in jail time, and/or a fine, as well as registering as a sex offender in the state of Washington.
