

STD Lesson Teacher Guide

Introduction:

Entry Task: Write on the board,

- “How is HIV transmitted?”
- “What does STD and STI stand for?”

Turn and talk with a neighbor to discuss your answers.

Launch Activity:

Open the Sexually Transmitted Disease PowerPoint. Hand out the STD Template or the Note Taking Template. Watch the Intro Video on STDs on the first slide. Discuss what STD are and the difference between a virus and bacteria. Ask the students to turn and talk to a neighbor and tell them one difference between the two.

Start the Sexually Transmitted Disease PowerPoint. You can have students use either of the two templates for students to fill out. Have them fill in their template while going through the PowerPoint.

Next, either hand out the Myths and Facts about HIV/AIDS sheet or put it up on Smartboard. If you hand the sheet out, then have them fill it out then turn and talk to their neighbor about their answers. If you are showing it on the Smartboard, leave it up so students can just discuss the questions. When finished, discuss answers as a class.

Hand out the Risk Recognition Activity. Have the students fill this out then discuss with their neighbors. Review as a class. Use the Risk Recognition Answer Sheet to go over the answers.

Exit Ticket/Homework:

Have the students fill out the STD Questions sheet as either an Exit Ticket or for Homework depending upon time.
