

## Classifying Contraception

<b>Classification: (some contraceptive methods fit multiple categories)</b>		
<b>BARRIER</b> Preventing sperm from reaching an egg	<b>HORMONAL</b> Preventing ovulation or inhibiting fertilization	<b>OTHER/SURGICAL</b> Using surgery or other procedures to make a person incapable of reproduction
<b><i>Pregnancy failure rate</i></b>		
100 % effective	Very effective <2%	Somewhat effective
<b><i>Protection against STDs</i></b>		
100% protection	Some protection	No protection
