- 1. ORAL SEX: Putting the mouth on someone's penis or vulva
- 2. VAGINAL SEX: Putting the penis inside of someone's vagina
- 3. ANAL SEX: Putting the penis inside of someone's anus

Contraception protects against...

- 1: Pregnancy
- 2: Some birth control methods also protect against STIs (Sexually transmitted infections)
- 3: Abstinence is the only method that 100% protects against both pregnancy and STIs

Barrier methods work by...

- ▶ Preventing sperm from reaching an egg



Hormonal methods work by...

Preventing ovulation or inhibiting fertilization

Hormonal methods **DO NOT** protect against STDs

reproduction
