Students planning on turning out for sports need to do the following:

- **Complete a sports physical**
  - Turn it to Mrs. Walker in the main office
  - Please make sure the physician completes their portion and signs it
  - Physicals are good for 24 months
- **Complete online packet through RankOne Sports - See link below**
- **Be Sure to indicate which sport(s) your child will participate in for the year**
- **Purchase an ASB card**
- **Pay the \$50 per sport participation fee per sport after tryouts and before the first game**
  - There is a maximum \$100 per year, per student
  - Athletic fees can be waived for students on free and reduced lunch – please provide a copy of the free/reduced lunch letter to Mrs. Dalrymple
  - Refunds will not be provided after the first contest

## Updates and Things to Note

**Skyward/Family Access** - [Skyward/Family Access](#) will be open for viewing transportation schedules, teacher assignments, student schedules, food service information and other important information beginning at 6 p.m. on Thursday, August 29. Please note that individual teacher assignments and student schedules may be subject to change up to the first day of school.

**No bags, including cinch sacks, in classrooms:** Students will be required to put all bags in lockers. While students can bring cinch sacks to school, just as they can backpacks, they will be required to put all bags in their locker for the day.

**Agendas:** Students will not be required to purchase agendas. Thank you to the Parent Club for providing all students with an agenda and school handbook. Students will receive their agenda the second week of school

**PE Uniforms** will be required when your student takes Life Fitness. PE uniforms may be purchased during Viking Days or before 2nd semester as needed. Uniforms will be handed out in class.

**Lockers:** Students are responsible for providing a quality lock for their student locker and PE Locker. PE locks must be combination only locks. Lockers will be assigned the second week of school.

**Medication at school:** If your child needs to take a prescription medication at school, you must have a SSD form signed by your doctor. See link below.
