*You may bring a lunch for you and your child or you may choose to purchase a lunch in our cafeteria (please note that lines may be long).

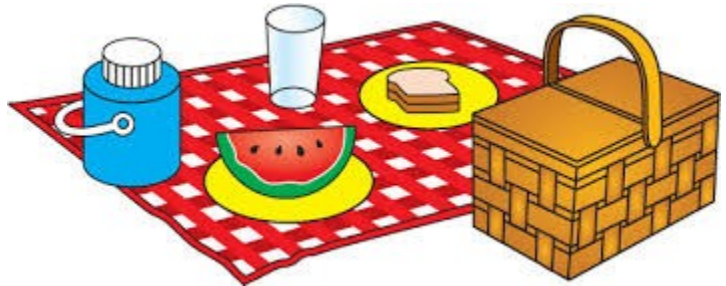
*Adult lunch price is \$3.50

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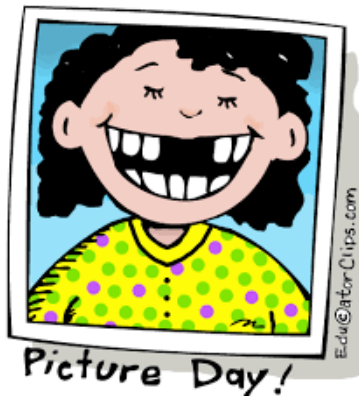
Evening of Great Expectations
