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Notes from the Nurses

Head lice protocol

In the SSD we do not exclude students from school due to head lice. It is at the discretion of the building nurse and principal whether we request that a student be picked up from school if they are identified as having head lice.

When a student is found positive for head lice:

Parents/guardians are notified by phone or by letter and given information about treatment options. Parents that are not involved will not receive notification letters.

Follow-up head checks may take place at school to help track success of treatment options.

The school nurse decides if other students need to be checked.

It is the responsibility of all parents to check their child's hair as often as possible and treat if head lice/nits (eggs) are found. Please let the office/school nurse know if you find head lice on your child. Remember that "anyone" can get head lice. They are not a "health" threat, do not fly or jump, and are not contracted from animals. Head-to-head contact is the main way a person contracts head lice, therefore, it is a good idea to check after sleepovers, family gatherings, school, sports or camp outings.

Just a reminder! Parents, please make sure your immunizations are up to date and that you have turned in update paperwork to the school. Remember, as of this school year, MMR is no longer allowed to be personally exempt (only religious or medical exemptions accepted).
