*Personalized Pathway Requirements (PPR): Up to 3.0 credits chosen by a student, that are included in a student's High School and Beyond Plan, and that prepare the student to meet specific post-secondary career or educational goals.

World Language

- Reasons to consider taking World Language:
- To meet World Language requirement for most colleges.
- Satisfy the two-year World Language graduation requirement by the end of senior year.
- To begin the practice of becoming fluent in a World Language.

If Juniors are planning on applying to Sno-Isle Tech junior and/or senior year or have an alternate path other than four year college, they should see their counselor about a PPR.

Additional Graduation Requirements

- Pass state assessments.
- Complete high school and beyond plan.
- 8 hours of community service completed senior year.

What's a PPR?

Up to 3.0 credits chosen by a student, that are included in a student's High School and Beyond Plan, and that prepare the student to meet specific post-secondary career or educational goals. This can replace up to 2 credits in world language and 1 credit in art.

Registration Directions

How to Register on Skyward

Logging On:

- Go to any Snohomish School District Family Access Portal
 - Search engine: Glacier Peak High School Skyward
 - Click on the Skyward / Family Access Log-On
 - You can also log in through Hello ID at sno.helloid.com
- Enter your STUDENT log-in and password (Not parent log-in/password)
- If you need help with your student login or password, contact:
 - GPHS: Any administrative assistant in the Counseling Office or see your School Counselor.
 - VVMS: The Register in the Main Office.

To add class requests:

- Click on the 'Schedule' link from the left-side menu
- Click on the 'Request Courses'
- Search and select courses from the list on left; Then click the 'Add Course' button
 - Total Credits should be 6.0 when finished
 - To remove a course, select the course you want to remove and click the 'Remove Course' button.

To add alternates— At least 4 alternate classes must be selected (10 may be selected):

- Choose the Alternates Tab at the top of the screen and follow the prompts.
- Choose carefully – These are classes you are willing to take if your first choices are unavailable. However, the more alternates you select, the easier it is to build your schedule. (Example: choose a different first-year World Language, a different elective, a different Senior English elective, etc.).

- Print your requests if you want a copy (alternates will not print).
