 - To feel confident in confronting situations that involve sexual abuse.



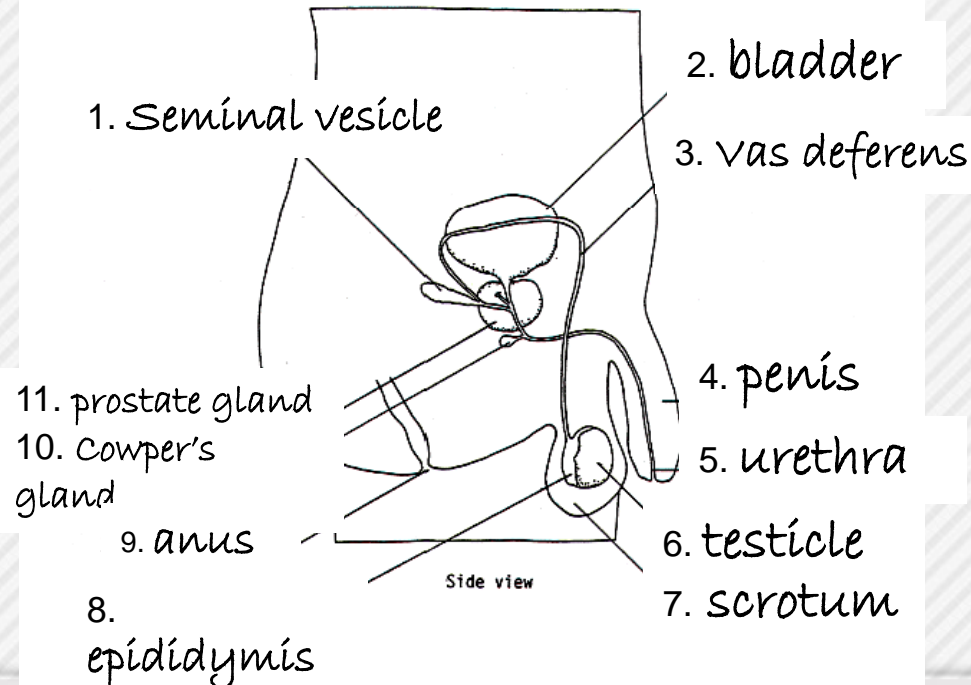

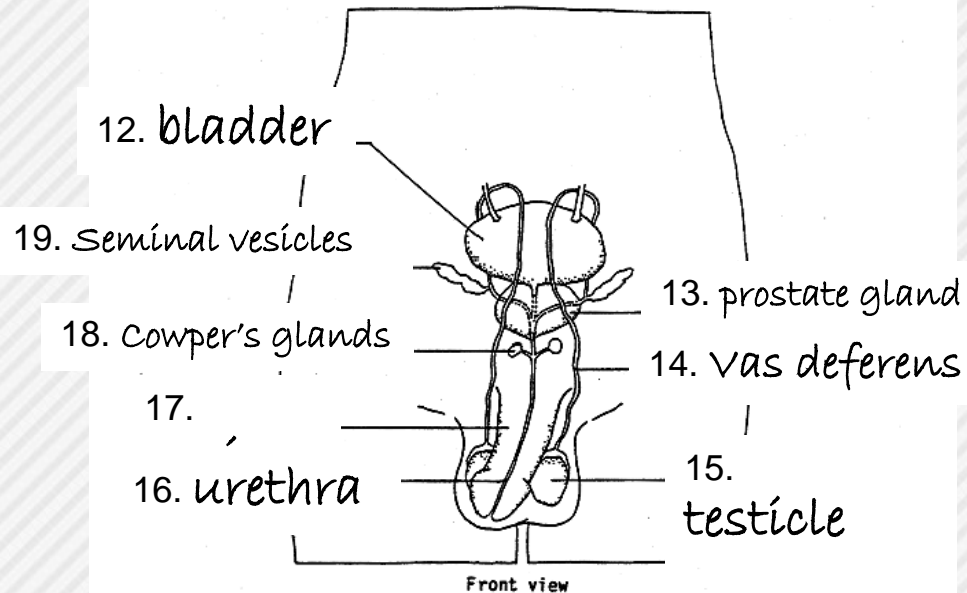

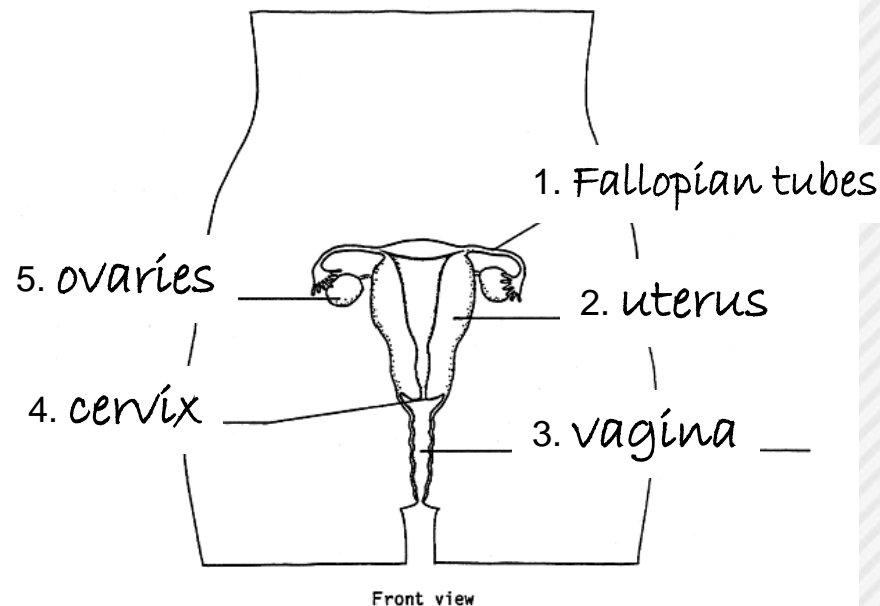
